

# **Assessment Methods**

Candidates will be awarded a diploma qualification upon satisfactorily fulfilling ALL of the following requirements:

- 1.75% Attendance in each module
- 2. Pass a multiple choice exam paper
- 3. Pass 4 discussion papers on diagnosis and management of diabetes and related diseases
- 4. Pass a 5000-word dissertation on a diabetes-related topic

For requirements 2-4, overall achievement will be graded from A to F with grade C or above being regarded as a pass.

# Fees
